

Show Day 2024 Indoor Exhibits – Home Options

KIWIANA THEME

*Section 1 - Juniors: Year 1-3s *Section 2 - Middles: Years 4-5 *Section 3 – Seniors: Years 6-8
We will also have a PRESCHOOL section if any pre-schoolers would like to enter.

1. WEAVING

Students to create a piece of weaving from harakeke (flax).

2. LEGO/MECCANO MODEL

Students create an original design with a kiwiana theme. This can be on a board but no larger than 40cm overall

3. DECORATED BISCUIT

Students decorate a biscuit with Kiwiana theme (Biscuit does not need to be baked by student).

4. FRUIT/VEGE CREATION

Using any fruit and or vegetable, students create a NZ animal. Toothpicks may be used to 'join' parts

5. SCULPTURE

Using clay, fimo, salt dough, playdough or similar material, students create a Kiwiana themed sculpture.

6. PET PROFILE

A poster display about your pet (show day animal or a pet at home). Include information like Pet name, date of birth, fun facts, pictures etc.

- **These items are OPTIONAL and to be made at home** They must be brought to school by 9am, Friday 18 October to display for judging.
- **Ideally to be started early and worked on through the term. It is up to individual children how many home entries they complete.**
- The displays will be open for viewing on Show Day **AFTER** the animal events
- Exhibits may be taken home at the end of the day.
- Flowers are needed on Friday 18 October. If you are able to bring extra flowers to share, please do.
